## VACATION CARE

Childcare: 7.00 am – 6.00 pm

Activities: 8.30 am – 5.00 pm

DAY COST: \$40.00 per day includes morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea & day activities.

To enable the camp to comply with childcare staffing ratios (1:15) you will be charged for the days you book in for. Applications close on Thursday prior to the commencement of your camp. Late applications and extra days will be subject to availability.

### PLEASE NOTE

- Camp Warrawee is a large open bush land area unlike most fenced school vacation care venues.
- **Due to the outdoor adventure activities offered, children must have completed a minimum of one term of Grade 1 (not prep) before they will be accepted at this vacation care program.**
- Children must be signed in on arrival and signed out on departure from camp.
- **The camp requires written permission to allow anyone different from the person who drops off your child, to pick up your child.**
- All children must be collected by 6.00pm or late fees will apply.
- **No confirmation is posted out, however if you wish to confirm your booking please phone camp on 3882 1436 or email [campwar@ymca.org.au](mailto:campwar@ymca.org.au)**
- Please advise prior to camp if your child has special requirements and include a management plan if necessary.
- **Soft drinks are available for sale at lunch time. Money must be brought in a marked wallet and handed in to the office on arrival.**

### **WE ARE A SUN SMART CAMP**

**All children need to wear shirts with sleeves, a full brim hat and use 30+ sunscreen**

Strappy or singlet tops, thongs, sandals, strapless or backless shoes **are not acceptable.**
